Some self refereeing may be necessary. There are medals for top veterans in each event (over 40) and intermediates in the foil event (fencers who have not previously won the event nor reached the last 4 of the County Foil Championship, nor have they reached the last 8 of a more senior event – schools events are not included in this restriction). Please bring your own refreshments as there are only a few vending machines at the venue.

All fencers must either be individual members of a BFA registered club or school based within the county of Kent, or permanently resident in Kent but registered with a club outside of Kent, when they are eligible to compete as unattached.

Fencers must be over the age of 13 on the day of the event.

ALL FENCERS MUST WEAR CLOTHING THAT COMPLIES WITH THE REGULATIONS THAT CAME INTO FORCE ON 01/01/06. ALL FENCERS MUST HOLD COMPETE BFA MEMBERSHIP.

Please note that neither the organiser, nor the KCAFU, nor the management of Polo Farm can be held responsible for any injury to persons attending the event, or for loss of or damage to belongings or equipment, how so ever caused.

All entries must be accompanied by the appropriate entry fees and the signature of a responsible adult if under 18. All fencers/attendees under the age of 18, MUST be accompanied by a parent or other responsible adult at all times.
